

2011 PORTLAND LOVE SHOW CONSIGNMENT AGREEMENT

This agreement is to make clear what you (referred to as "the Artist" hereafter) can & cannot expect from the Love Show (a joint production of Launch Pad Gallery, Gallery Homeland, Po'boy Arts & Chris Haberman Presents) regarding the FEBRUARY 2011 Love Show, and in turn, what we expect from you; signing a copy of this agreement is a condition of participating in this show, so please read it carefully!

1. **LIABILITY:** While we will do everything in our power to keep artwork safe and free from damage or theft, the Love show exists within a public building with uncontrolled access; consequently, neither the Love show, Gallery Homeland nor the Ford building or any of the businesses/associated entities within can accept *any liability* for artwork. **Simply put, you the Artist are showing your work at your own risk.**
2. **SALES:** *Works do not have to be for sale*, but if they are, The Love Show will take 40% of the sale price of all work; the Artist will receive 60% of the sale price.
3. **PAYMENT:** The Love Show will pay the full amount owed to the Artist within 30 days of the close of the show (by March 29th, 2011) excluding scenarios where there is a payment plan in place*, in which case, LPG will pay whatever money has been paid-to-date on a monthly basis or as otherwise arranged.
4. **PROMOTIONAL COSTS:** The Artist agrees to contribute \$10.00 towards the costs associated with promoting and producing the show (show cards, vinyl lettering, permitting), deliverable upon drop-off of artwork unless otherwise arranged.
5. **WORK PICK UP: All Artwork must be retrieved at the close of the show (February 27th, 2011)** Once the show comes down, there is nowhere to store art & the chances of damage increase exponentially. Because this has been a big problem with group shows, our strict policy is that **TWO WEEKS after the close of the show, all unclaimed artwork irrecoverably becomes property of the Love Show. Get your work during pick up times if you want to keep it; On March 14th, 2011, it's ours.**
6. **MISCELLANY:** In order to legally sell alcohol at our events, food has to be available for the duration, and also, hopefully your friends will be coming to this show, so... **It's a Potluck!** Please bring a food item that you would like to eat and share to the opening. This is potluck style, friends, there is no expectation that you spend a lot of money, just that you bring something good to eat and plenty of it. And tell your friends, too! It allows us to keep the booze cheap, and everyone likes that.

Not to get all heavy about it, but as an artist, you should expect some sort of agreement when you participate in any art show, whether it's at a gallery or a coffee shop, discussing what your rights and responsibilities are, and what the venue's are; it's totally fair for you to ask for a *clear understanding* of what the terms of your show are and, if you feel it to be necessary, to ask for it in writing; if the other party is hesitant or weird about it, I would strongly consider whether you want to show there.
